

Beginning November 28, 2023	The housing application opened for new, first year students. Every Monday, students who submitted their \$90 enrollment fee the week prior will receive an email from Housing (sent to SRU email) regarding how to complete the housing application. You can select your roommate or roommates (up to 3) any time now. <i>See information below</i>
Group 1: New students who have completed housing application thru February 29, 2024	<p><i>Students can search for the name of their intended roommate(s) if they have one in mind.</i> Students in this group may select their actual room beginning Thursday, March 7 at 12:30PM; check your MyHousing portal after 10:00AM for your unique selection time. Only one member of your group needs to go in and select from the group. You must be matched* with your intended roommate/s and you will only see available rooms in your approved LLC and/or styles that match the number in your group. (i.e. 3 matched will see and select triple).</p> <p>March 12 – 29 will be the room selection for students who do not have an intended roommate for Group 1. If you do not select a room within this period, you can wait until April as there will be different people in the pool by then.</p> <p>*matched = selected one another in MyHousing portal.</p>
Group 2: New students who have completed housing application between March 1 – April 1	<p>Students in this group may select their room starting Thursday, April 4 @ 12:30PM; check your MyHousing portal after 10:00AM for your unique selection time. <i>More detailed information will be sent to your SRU email a few days prior to this selection.</i></p> <p>April 9-30 is the room selection time for students who don't have a roommate or who haven't selected their room.</p>
Students that completed on-campus housing agreement after April 2, or anyone who has yet to select their room	The Housing Office will do your placement for you.

Reasons why you can't find your intended roommate(s) to send them a roommate request:

1. Did they submit their \$90 enrollment fee and complete their housing application?
2. Did they select an are approved for the LLC you selected/were approved?
3. Is their application incomplete (parental verification for those under 18)?
4. Do they already have a housing placement?
5. Is your roommate an upper-class student?

Helpful hints:

If you mark that you would like to live in a Living and Learning Community, you will only see rooms open in that particular building which are available for you to select.

Building A: College of Health, Environment and Engineering and College of Health Professions

Building B: ROCK Athletics LLC floors; College of Business

Watson Hall: College of Education and Honors only

Building D: College of Liberal Arts
