After July 1, 2017

Several items need to be completed via the MyHousing portal (<https://reslife.sru.edu>):

- Change meal plan, by Sept 8. *Can only do this once.*
- SIGN UP FOR A MOVE-IN DAY and TIME.
- Early Arrival Form (*if absolutely necessary*). We discourage this to allow first year students to experience the fun of WOW, though Athletic Teams/Groups may make arrangements for you to arrive early.

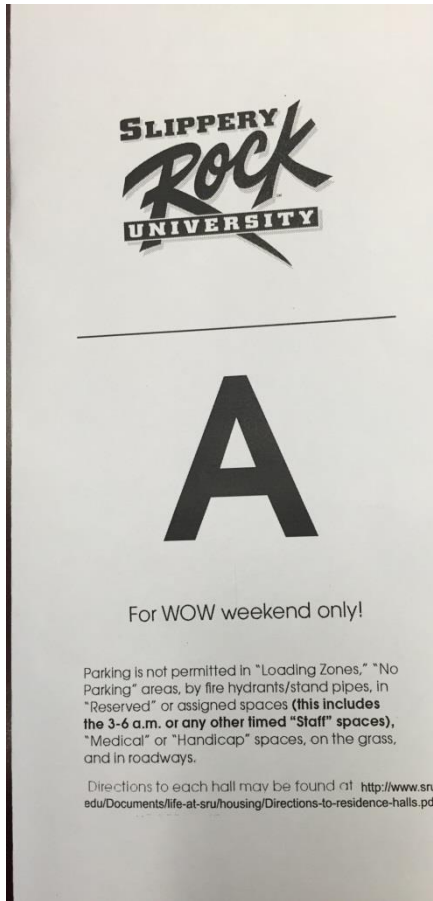
After July 1, 2017

Several items need to be completed via the MyHousing portal (<https://reslife.sru.edu>):

- Fill out student information form, which will provide in depth contact information.
- Your student can sign up for our free wireless internet service (MyResnet). The link to sign-up is listed on the MyHousing page.

Arrival Day, Moving In:

- You will log onto your MyHousing portal after July 1 and sign up for an arrival time: Thursday, August 24 9:00AM-4:00PM OR Friday, August 25 9:00AM-1:00PM
Classes begin Monday, August, 28
- WOW volunteers will come to your car and help you unpack all belongings. “Stop. Drop. Go!” *Please label all items with name, room number, and hall.*
- You may bring your own dolly or cart, with demand availability can be limited.



You will be mailed a brightly colored "hangtag" parking pass for move-in day. This identifies your residence hall and makes it easier for Police and WOW volunteers to provide direction



STOP! DROP! GO!

- **WOW Volunteers will unload students belongings**

After unloaded, driver will move car to parking and can take a courtesy shuttle back to the building

Student can begin check in, parent/friend can stay with belongings, if needed.

- **Packing suggestions:**

Label belongings with name & room number

Prepare for inclement weather

- Bring a plastic tarp

- Use plastic totes and/or large trash bags



AT CHECK IN, YOU WILL NEED:

- **\$20.00 House Council Fee.** This is used for programming for the academic year.
 - Please have cash or make check payable to your building house council (Ex: Building A House Council)
- **Student ID Card.** Staff will encode this card for your Residence Hall Room.
- **Immunization / Meningitis Records or Waiver** (*if not turned in already*)

ALL MOVED IN...NOW WHAT?

- Parent, families and guests often help unpack, but *plan a departure time to allow student to participate in WOW Activities.*
- **Many events are planned to allow students to learn the campus, residence halls, and meet other freshmen/students.** Floor meetings to help students get to know “neighbors” and classmates. Activities for fun and to encourage social interaction.

FIRST SEMESTER REMINDERS:

- Halls DO NOT close for **Fall Break Oct 9- Oct 10**
- Halls DO close for **Thanksgiving Nov 22 – Nov 26** and **Winter Break Dec 16- Jan 21**
- Break Housing Requests can be made on the MyHousing Portal
- Many floor, hall and campus activities each month
- Direct your student to our staff, we are always glad to help and assist!
- **Housing Contract process for Fall 2018 will be October-January;** use the MyHousing Portal for this process.
