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3+3 REQUIREMENTS FOR ALL MAJORS

- You must maintain a 3.0 or higher overall QPA.
- You may not have more than one "W" in a required course in the 3+3 block.
- You can only be in the 3+3 program for a maximum of three (3) years full-time continuous enrollment. If any of these requirements are not met, the 3+3 designation will be removed from your record by your Advisor.
- Should 3+3 Physical Therapy students be unsuccessful in completing the 1st year (either Fall and/or spring semesters) of the DPT program and want to complete their original undergraduate degree, it is solely up to the discretion of their undergraduate program coordinator to determine which, if any, physical therapy courses will count toward the completion of their undergraduate degree. In addition, students must complete any unfulfilled requirements of his/her undergraduate major.
