Minor Requirements:

- Students must complete at least 6 credit hours in their minor from SRU
- A minimum of 9 credit hours must be upper division (an upper division course includes any 3 credit course that requires a pre-requisite)
- A minor shall be no fewer than 15 credits.
- A minor requires at least 4 additional credits that are outside the student's major.

**QPA REQUIREMENT

- Students who do not meet minimum standards will be dismissed from the program. All dismissals are permanent.
- If PSYC221 or PSYC325/326 are taken, students must earn a C or higher, and the courses can only be repeated once. Enrollment in subsequent courses requiring one of these courses as a prerequisite will not be permitted until the minimum grade of C is earned.
