3+3 REQUIREMENTS FOR ALL MAJORS

- You must maintain a 3.0 or higher overall QPA.
- You may not have more than one "W" in a required course in the 3+3 block.
- You can only be in the 3+3 program for a maximum of three (3) years full-time continuous enrollment. If any of these requirements are not met, the 3+3 designation will be removed from your record by your Advisor.
- Should 3+3 Physical Therapy students be unsuccessful in completing the 1st year (either Fall and/or spring semesters) of the DPT program and want to complete their original undergraduate degree, it is solely up to the discretion of their undergraduate program coordinator to determine which.
