SRU POST-BACCALAUREATE POLICY FOR THOSE SEEKING INITIAL TEACHER OR SCHOOL NURSE CERTIFICATION

All applicants to these areas of study must read and initial.

It is the policy of Slippery Rock University's College of Education not to accept post-baccalaureate candidates into any initial Teacher Certification program if they have not earned either an undergraduate or graduate degree QPA of at least 2.8 on a 4.0 scale. Therefore, although an applicant may be admitted to the University for post-baccalaureate study, if the applicant does not meet the above criteria, he/she will not be permitted to enroll in any courses leading to initial certification.

If the applicant's degree QPA was a 2.5 to 2.79 and it has been more than three years since graduation, probationary status **may** be possible. For additional information regarding the possibility of probationary admission, contact the College of Education at 724-738-2007.

If the applicant meets the QPA requirement for regular admission, he/she should contact the College of Education to request the Post Baccalaureate Application for Admission to Teacher Certification Programs. This COE application must be submitted subsequent to the approval of this Post Baccalaureate Admission Application to the University.

NOTE: School Nurse Certificate applicants are not required to complete this process.

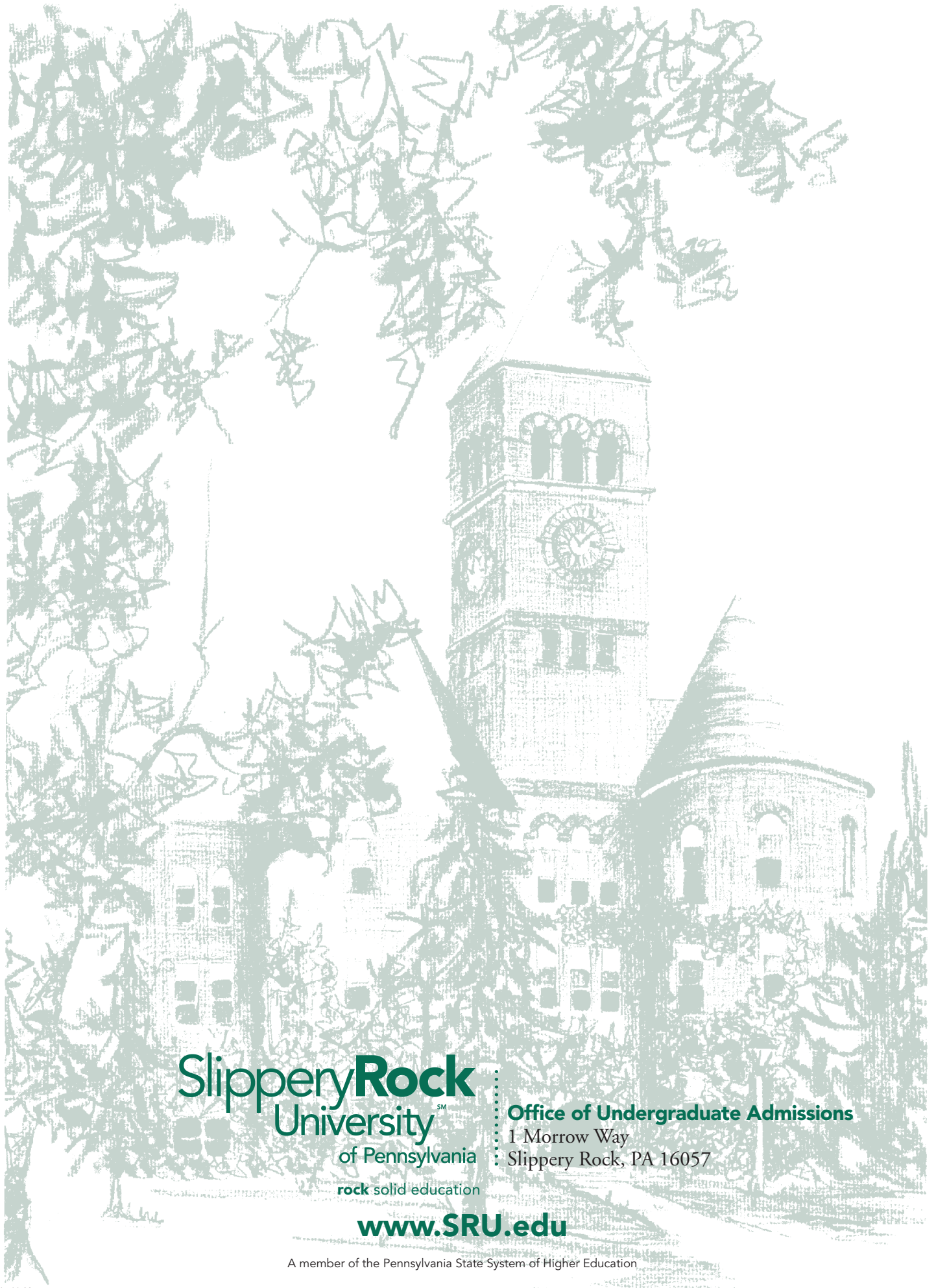
