

<u>Luzerne County Community College to SRU – Transfer Credit Guide</u>

This guide corresponds with the Rock Studies component (general education) of the SRU curricula and provides Luzerne course suggestions for each area. Because this guide is generic, students should review their Luzerne course plans with an SRU transfer counselor, as some majors may prescribe specific courses in the categories below.
