

WiFi - Connecting to sru1x

Apple – iOS v16.6.1 (these instructions may vary for older iOS versions)

Mac book and mobile devices:

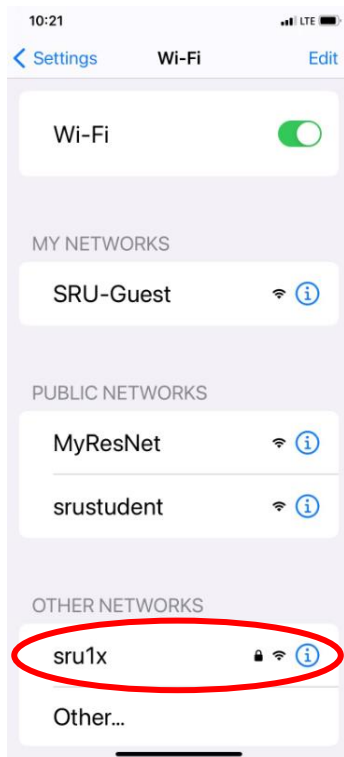


Step 1: Go to 'Settings'



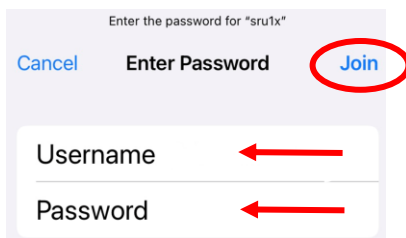
Step 2: Select 'Wi-Fi'

Step 3: Within the list of available networks select 'sru1x'

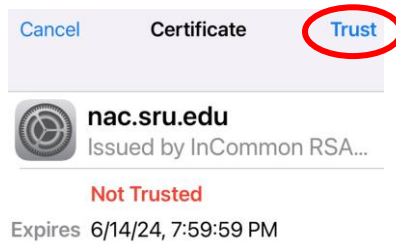


Step 4: Enter your SRU username and password
NOTE: you do **NOT** need to include @sru.edu

Step 5: Select 'Join'



Step 6: Select 'Trust'



Android Mobile devices:



Step 1: Go to 'Settings'



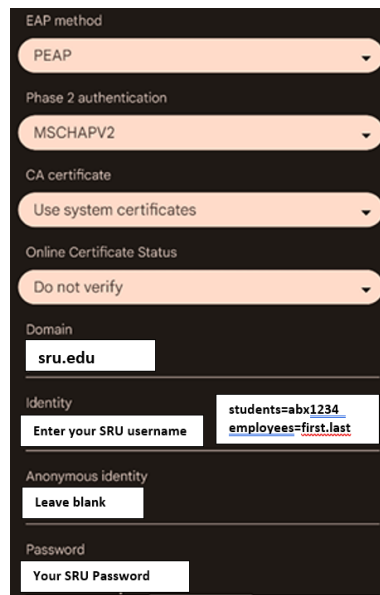
Step 2: Select 'Connections'

Step 3: Select 'Wi-Fi' ensure it is turned on



Step 4: Select 'sru1x'

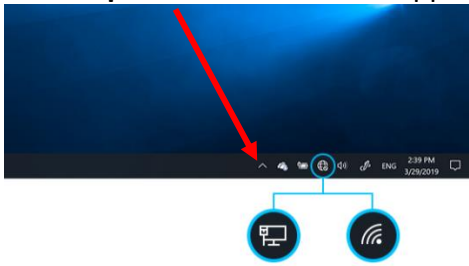
Step 5: Enter your login information:

- Set EAP Method to 'PEAP'
- Set Phase 2 authentication to 'MSCHAPV2'
- Set CA Certificate to 'Use system certificates'
- Set Online Certificate Status to 'Do not verify'
- Set Domain to sru.edu
- Set Identity to your SRU username
NOTE: do NOT include @sru.edu
Students=abc1234; Employees=first.last
- Set Password to your SRU password
- Leave "Anonymous Identity" empty
- Tap "Connect"



Windows 10 – PC

Step 1: Select the 'Network'  icon on the taskbar. The icon that appears depends on your current connection state. If you don't see one of the network icons (or a similar one) shown in the following image, select the 'Up arrow'  to see if it appears there.



Step 2: Choose the Wi-Fi network 'sru1x'

Step 3: Check the box 'Connect automatically'

Step 4: Select 'Connect'

Step 5: Enter your SRU username and password

NOTE: you do **NOT** need to include @sru.edu

Step 6: Select 'Next'

Chromebook

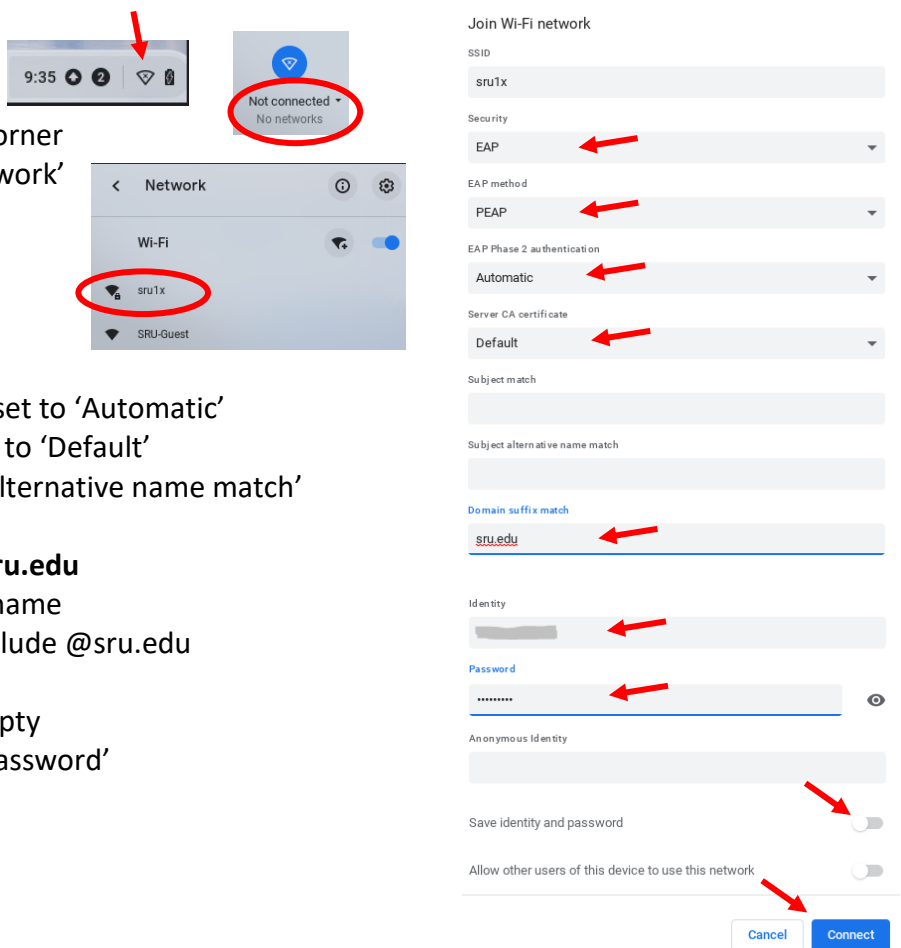
Step 1: Click on the wireless radio icon near the clock in the lower right corner

Step 2: Select 'Not connected' or 'No network'

Step 3: Select 'sru1x'

Step 4: Use the following information:

- SSID will default to sru1x
- Security will be 'EAP'
- Set EAP Method to 'PEAP'
- Leave Phase 2 authentication set to 'Automatic'
- Leave Server CA certificate set to 'Default'
- 'Subject match' and 'Subject Alternative name match' are left blank
- Set 'Domain suffix match' to **sru.edu**
- 'Identity' enter your SRU username
NOTE: you do **NOT** need to include @sru.edu
- Enter your SRU password
- Leave Anonymous Identity empty
- Toggle on 'Save identity and password'
- Select 'Connect'



***NOTE - If your device is requesting entry for the following fields, please try the following:**

- EAP Method - PEAP
- Phase 2 Authentication - MSCHAPv2
- CA Certificate - Do not validate or Use system certificate
- User name and password - confirm password is not expired.
- Domain – sru.edu or identity is username@sru.edu or SRUNET\username
- Privacy – Randomize MAC should be disabled
