CHARLES M. BENNETT MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP AWARD

The Charles M. Bennett Memorial Scholarship was established by the family of Dr. Charles M. Bennett, who was a professor of Counseling and Development at Slippery Rock University from 1963-1986. The Scholarship provides a monetary award. The award is intended to recognize a high level of academic achievement as well as evidence of financial need.

Application Requirements:

1. Permanent Residency. Applicants shall be Pennsylvania residents.
2. Degree Candidacy. Applicants shall be accepted to Degree Candidacy within a Graduate Program in the Department of Counseling and Development.
3. Academic Achievement. Applicants shall demonstrate a minimal overall graduate QPA of 3.5.
4. Psychological Testing. Applicants must have completed Principles of Appraisal. Interest in the area of Psychological Testing shall be specifically considered.
5. Financial Need. Applicants shall provide evidence of financial need and explain how the Charles M. Bennett Memorial Scholarship Award would assist in the pursuance of graduate study at Slippery Rock University, and/or as a professional counselor.
6. Student Status. Both part-time and full-time graduate students shall be eligible for this award.
7. Frequency of Award. Any recipient of this award shall not be eligible for consideration a second time.
8. Completion of Scholarship Application. (Available at the Department of Counseling and Development information rack and the Counseling and Development department office).

No distinction shall be made based upon race, color, or creed.

The amount of each scholarship award shall not exceed \$700 or the amount of the net income accumulated during the previous calendar year from investment of the principal gift. If all of the income from any one-year is not used in the next award, the excess shall be available for use in succeeding years.
