

## **SRU Presidential Search Committee membership gets Chancellor's approval**

**SLIPPERY ROCK, Pa.** – The Slippery Rock University Presidential Search Committee has received approval of its membership from Frank Brogan, chancellor of Pennsylvania's State System of Higher Education.

The full complement of Search Committee members was selected at the SRU Council of Trustees March 9 meeting.

Membership on the committee is prescribed by Pennsylvania's State System Board of Governors Policy Section 1983-13-A: Process for Recommending a Presidential Appointment.

"I find the Search Committee list (that was) presented to be in compliance with the Board policy regarding the search procedure and committee membership, Section B.2.a & b., and extend approval for the committee to proceed with the presidential search for Slippery Rock University," said Brogan.

Kathleen Howley, deputy vice chancellor for academic and student affairs, will serve as the chancellor's liaison on the Search Committee. In this capacity, Howley will act as a nonvoting member of the Presidential Search Committee.

"We are very pleased that the Chancellor's Office so quickly approved the Search Committee membership and we look forward to moving forward with the process," said Matt Lautman, chair of SRU's Council of Trustees.

The committee will have its first meeting April 12.
