

Presidential Search Update: SRU's presidential candidate visits conclude

SLIPPERY ROCK, Pa. - The Slippery Rock University Presidential Search Committee concluded onsite visits with the third of three candidates that are vying to become the next president of the University, Sept. 29.

Throughout the week each candidate visited campus for public interviews with students, faculty, staff, administrators, alumni and community members.

Candidates invited for campus interviews included:

-Marsha Krotseng, president of Bluefield State College, Bluefield, West Virginia. Krotseng was interviewed Sept. 25.

-Bruce Murphy, president of Nicholls State University, Thibodaux, Louisiana. Murphy was interviewed Sept. 27.

-Amir Mohammadi, vice president for finance, administration and advancement services at Slippery Rock University. Mohammadi was interviewed Sept. 29.

People were provided with a 24-hour window following each interview to provide feedback to the Search Committee via an electronic survey managed by the search firm. AGB Search.

The Search Committee expects to send the names of two of the three candidates to the University's council of trustees for approval at their Oct. 5-6 meeting. If approved, the names will be forwarded to Pennsylvania's State System of Higher Education board of governors who will interview them and select the next president.
