

Attention all SRU Students

New Fall 2019-2020 Parking Permit Process

Starting July 15, 2019 all Parking Permits for the Fall 2019/Spring 2020 semesters will be available for sale and **must be purchased ONLINE**. There will be **no over-the-counter permit sales available in the Parking & ID Card Office from Aug. 19th thru Sept. 6th**, please purchase your permits online.

Once your online purchase is completed, your decal will be immediately available for pickup. *Faster service means smaller lines!*

Please visit: <https://www.sru.edu/offices/parking> and follow the prompts to purchase your pass prior to the start of the fall 2019 semester. Your permit can be picked up in the lobby of the University Union, just outside of the Parking & ID Card Office during the following times:

August 22 – 23, 2019

7:30 a.m. – 5 p.m.

August 24 – 25, 2019

10 a.m. – 5 p.m.

If you are visiting campus or are an early returning student during the dates of July 1 – August 21, 2019, feel free to stop in the Parking & ID Card Office, 102 University Union to pick up your purchased parking decal. Normal hours of operation are: Monday – Friday, 7:30 a.m. – 4 p.m. Any questions, please call the Parking Office at 724.738.4785.

With the implementation of a new parking software system coming for the Spring of 2020 semester, all fall 2019 parking permits sold online will be made through our current parking software system. With your fall 2019 parking permit purchase, you will still be receiving a Parking Permit decal that, as in the past, must be placed on the inside drivers side of your windshield.

But good news! Starting January of 2020, the pass you purchased in the fall **will still be valid until August of 2020** but you will no longer need the decal permit stuck to your windshield. All permits then will be utilized through license plate recognition within our new Passport Parking System. Permits purchased in January 2020 will be purchased online through our new Passport System with no physical permit required to be applied to your windshield. More information on the new system, how it works and what you need to do to utilize it will be shared at a later date.
