Quarterly Reporting Requirement for the CRRSAA and ARPA Student Pandemic Relief for the period ending September 30, 2021.

Slippery Rock University of Pennsylvania has signed and returned to the Department of Education the <u>Certification and Agreement form</u> for the CRRSAA and ARPA (American Recovery Plan Act) programs to provide Emergency Financial Aid Grants to Students.

Slippery Rock University has received \$17,351,637 in total to be provided to students in the form of emergency financial aid grants to students.

As of 9/30/2021, \$15,881,170 has been used by Slippery Rock University for emergency aid to students.

As of 9/30/2021, 9,851 students have received this funding.

An estimated 8,400 students are currently potentially eligible for these funds.

Slippery Rock University uses a combination of block grants to students with known need as demonstrated by their FAFSA generated EFC as well as an emergency aid application to identify other students with emergency need. We continue to apply HEERF funds in this manner by automatically identifying students with need expressed by their FAFSA as well with as an emergency aid application.

Quarterly reporting will continue as required.
