4. This application is for the one semester indicated in Item B. Students must reapply each term.
5. Senior Citizens who would like to take an undergraduate course for credit will need to apply through the Undergraduate Admissions office as a non-degree student or a degree-seeking student if they wish to earn an undergraduate degree. Senior Citizens who take an undergraduate course for credit will be charged in full for tuition and fees associated with the course(s).
6. Senior Citizen students who would like to take a graduate class for credit will need to apply through the Graduate Admissions office. Senior Citizens who take a graduate course for credit will be charged in full for tuition and fees associated with the course(s). Graduate courses cannot be audited.
