1. Senior Citizens may register for classes on a space available basis.
2. Senior Citizens must show proof of being at least 62 years of age before the beginning of the semester/term for which they are applying.
3. Senior Citizens must show proof of being "... on social security or equivalent retirement benefits\*..." Board of State College and
4. University Directors – 6/19/75.
5. \*Senior Citizens, age 62 and older, who cannot submit proof of receiving retirement benefits, may submit a signed statement attesting to one of the following:
  - a. He/she is not currently working and based upon his/her previous work history, he/she is not eligible to receive social security or any form of equivalent retirement benefits.
  - b. He/she is not currently working and he/she has elected to defer receiving his/her social security or equivalent retirement benefits to a later time.
6. Registrations will not be accepted until one week prior to the beginning of classes.
7. If taken for credit, the fee waiver covers only the basic tuition fee. Other fees will be billed to the student. Course texts and materials are the responsibility of the student.
8. If taken on an "audit" basis, no tuition or fees will be charged. Course texts and materials are the responsibility of the student.
9. This application is for the one semester indicated in Item B. **Students must reapply each semester/term.**
10. Senior Citizens may not register for an independent study, individualized instruction or any other course in which the instructor will be compensated over and beyond his/her regular salary. Senior Citizens who wish to register for these courses must pay **in full** for the classes whether they are taken for a grade or are audited.
