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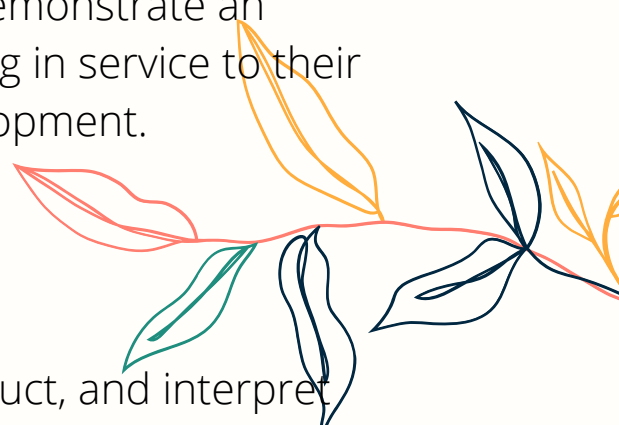
Graduates will be able to demonstrate an orientation to active learning in service to their ongoing professional development.
