

# **EMPOWERING EDUCATORS:** INTEGRATING NEW TECHNOLOGIES INTO TEACHER EDUCATION

The global introduction of ChatGPT in early 2023 reverberated throughout higher education and society at large. Faculty members found themselves grappling with the challenge of determining the optimal response to this technological breakthrough–whether to resist, embrace or cautiously integrate it into their teaching methodologies.

Recognizing the inevitability of this technological shift, faculty members at the Slippery Rock University College of Education swiftly moved to accept and integrate artificial-intelligence powered tools into teacher education programs. For instance, Hye Ryung Won, assistant professor of elementary and early childhood education, who taught a Creativity Integration Method course in the spring of 2023, explored innovative ways to incorporate Al into her curriculum. In her course, preservice teachers were tasked with crafting children's storybook books, utilizing a range of text generative Als (e.g., ChatGPT, Microsoft Bing) and image generative Als (e.g., Dall-E2, Midjourney). The central aim of this activity was not solely to produce storybooks relying on AI, but rather to involve students' original ideas and imaginations in developing their storylines, followed by AI-assisted development and refinement for efficiency. Ethical considerations regarding copyright, when supported by Al, were thoroughly discussed, leading to the agreement to attribute credit to the AI tools by explicitly listing them as co-authors on the students' creative work.

The exploration of AI-powered tools with teacher educators continued. Elizabeth LaGamba, associate professor of elementary and early childhood education, who taught a Literacy Method course in the fall of 2023, presented an interactive workshop with her students entitled "Navigating Artificial Intelligence (AI) in the Literacy Classroom" at the Keystone State Literacy Association Annual Conference in Hershey, Pennsylvania, in November 2023. In preparing this workshop, students seized the opportunity to actively explore and evaluate the functionalities and efficacy of commonly utilized AI programs (e.g., Wordtune, QuillBot, OtterAl, Curipod, Moonbeam, Imagine Forest, etc.). During the workshop, attendees actively participated in a dialogue led by SRU students, regarding the advantages and potential drawbacks of AI programs. Consequently, whole attendees were prompted to contemplate adjustments to their policies and teaching methods, acknowledging the implications of this emerging technology.

As such, through practical experiences integrating Al into teaching and learning, faculty realized the importance of involving students in explicit discussions about responsible Al use. This approach, combined with hands-on exploration of various strategies, proved more beneficial than imposing restrictions alone, which could lead to unwarranted anxieties. Faculty members believe such engagement could nurture students into critical and responsible citizens who use Al judiciously.

As of 2024, the proactive stance and actions of faculty members toward technology integration in teacher education continue under the active support of Keith Dils, dean of the College of Education. Dils allocated funds for faculty to attend the Pennsylvania Educational Technology Expo & Conference. The College of Education's technology committees utilized this privilege to explore various educational technology tools at the conference, assessing their suitability for Pre-K-12 education and examining possibilities for incorporating them into teacher training to enhance preparedness in technological competency.

After gaining insights at the PETE&C on diverse learning technology instruments (e.g., robot coding and programming for PreK-12, virtual reality devices designed for children with special needs, English language learners and beyond), the technology committees have actively elaborated on ideas to formulate a strategic plan for introducing such diverse educational technologies and approaches into the College of Education. They believe this initiative ultimately empowers preservice teachers to enter the education profession with ample knowledge and skills in educational technologies to effectively teach future generations. With this vision in mind,
