Application Deadline: Last Friday in October



Overview

- Merit based award designed to support remarkable PhD students in applied physical, biological, and engineering sciences
- Awards recipient full tuition equivalent up to 5 years, \$34,000 personal stipend
 - Also an option to coordinate award with other fellowships
- Recipients can pursue a PhD at one of 40 participating universities
 - Opportunity for additional schools to be considered

Eligibility Requirements

- U.S. citizen or permanent resident
- Undergraduate Senior or graduate student in first year of program
- Pursuing/ interested in pursuing a PhD in the fields of:
 - Applied Physical Science
 - Biological Sciences
 - Mathematics
 - Engineering
- Recipients must be willing to commit their skills to the United States in times of national emergency

Application Materials

- Online Application completed by applicant
 - Hertz Foundation Fellowship does not require an endorsement from our office, but you are still encouraged to collaborate with us to improve your chances
- Transcripts
 - Unofficial may work for initial application, but if shortlisted you will need an official copy
- 300-word essays
- 4 letters of recommendation written in "Hertz Fellowship Format"
- GRE/ equivalent graduate school test scores (Aptitude portion of the GRE is required)
- If shortlisted, candidates will participate in an in-person interview
