

## **Marshall Scholarships**

**Application Deadline: Mid October**



### **General Overview**

- Designed to help finance students who are interested in studying for a degree program in the United Kingdom
  - Graduate school level in any field of study
- Up to 40 different individuals are awarded this scholarship a year
- Promotes the advancement of knowledge in Science, Technology, humanities, social sciences, and the creative arts at Britain's centers of academic excellence
- The scholarship covers all of the following expenses:
  - University fees, cost of living, annual book grant, thesis grant, research and training grant, travel fares to and from the United States, and in some cases contributions towards a dependent spouse.
- Two options of awards: two years (22 months) or one year (12 months)

### **Eligibility Requirements**

- U.S. citizen by the time of applying for the scholarship
- Hold at least one undergraduate degree from an accredited 4-year college or university in the United States by the time of taking up the scholarship
- Received no less than a 3.7 GPA (not rounded)
- Graduated from their institution after April 2015
- Not holding a degree or degree-equivalent qualification from a British University or GCSE or A Levels taken at school in the UK.
- Candidates are advised to consider the objectives of the Marshall Scholarship before applying

### **Application Materials**

- Complete the online application
  - Candidates will choose to apply to either the 1 year or 2 years. Applying to both will result in disqualification
  - Candidates can apply to either the region of their institution or their home address region
- All materials are approved and submitted by a campus representative. Students must first apply for a letter of endorsement based on the institution's application deadlines
- Both an online and mailed hard copy of Candidate's official transcripts must be sent
- Four Letters of Recommendation
