UNDERGRADUATE ADMISSIONS

Slippery Rock University uses a rolling admission process, so students can expect personal and timely updates on application decisions throughout the year. Consideration for admission is selective based on academic record, school leaving exams and English language proficiency.

APPLICATION DEADLINES

For August enrollment, students should apply early in the preceding academic year and no later than May 1. For January enrollment, the deadline is October 1.

 - Bank statement
 - Financial support statement
- ❑ **Copy of passport biographical page**

LIVING ON CAMPUS

SRU is a great place to live and learn. Whether you're from a big city or a small town, SRU offers a close-knit community that feels like home. On-campus housing provides a fun, friendly and safe environment. You'll know your neighbors and feel comfortable in your surroundings.

SCHOLARSHIPS

Out-of-state tuition reduction – \$3,500

Requirement to maintain award: 2.5 GPA or higher.

Provost Scholarship for Global Diversity and Academic Achievement – \$1,500

Requirement to maintain award: 3.0 GPA or higher. Only applicable for Freshmen and Transfer students.

Presidential Award for Academic Excellence – \$500

Requirement to maintain award: 3.5 GPA or higher. Only available during second year of study and onward.

Honors College – \$6,000 (\$1,500 annual increments)

Admissions criteria includes online application, one- to two-page essay, resume of extracurricular activities, SAT 1220 or ACT 25 OR letter of recommendation, and high school GPA of 3.8 or higher. Scholarships are available to incoming freshmen, but are limited.

Additional scholarships are available by application after the first year of study. Scholarships are only applied to the fall and spring terms. For more details regarding costs and scholarships, visit www.sru.edu/internationaladmissions.

Global Engagement

Office staff help students and faculty traveling overseas and support international students from the application and enrollment process to graduation and beyond.

Success Coaches
