Transfer students must have a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.8 to be offered unconditional admission into any education program. Students are responsible for curriculum requirements at the time of enrollment at SRU. Because curriculum may change from the point of beginning community college classes to enrolling at SRU, it is recommended that students occasionally consult an SRU transfer counselor.
