ADD-ON CERTIFICATION NOTES:

- Secondary Education teachers may add other subject areas to their certification by passing the appropriate certification test at the 3.0 GPA level.
- Secondary Education may add on grades 4, 5, and 6 by passing the three-module PA Grades 4-8 Core Assessment Praxis test at the 3.0 GPA level.
- Certification areas not available through testing alone include: American Sign Language, Cooperative Education, HPE, Reading Specialist, and Special Education.
