This email is to make you aware that you are receiving emergency funding from Slippery Rock University's allocation of Higher Education Emergency Relief Funds provided for by the Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security Act, also known as the CARES Act. These funds are being disbursed directly to you due to the break in instruction you have experienced, as well as the shift to online learning due to the COVID-19 pandemic and related safety measures.

Using your current Free Application for Federal Student Aid, also known as FAFSA, the University has on record, as well as the corresponding Expected Family Contribution, or EFC, it has been determined that you are eligible for this \$500 emergency grant. This money can be used for any expenses related to your education, including any outstanding bill you may have, food, housing, course materials, technology needs, health care or child care.

You should expect to receive this money via either direct deposit or live check sent to your permanent home address on or around May 5-6.
