To the University Community:

Slippery Rock University, in conjunction with the Slippery Rock Giant Eagle, will host its second COVID-19 vaccination clinic for faculty, staff and students. The clinics will take place from 9 a.m. to 1 p.m., May 19 & 21, at the Russell Wright Alumni House.

Persons that attended the April 21 & 23 clinics will be able to obtain the second dose of the Moderna vaccine to complete their series of shots.

Unvaccinated persons can be seen as a walk-in (no appointment needed) and will have the choice to receive the Johnson & Johnson one-dose vaccine OR the first dose of the Moderna vaccine. If Moderna is selected, the second dose will be scheduled with the Slippery Rock Giant Eagle pharmacy while at the clinic.

All persons that attend the vaccination clinic are required to adhere to the University's mitigation efforts including physical distancing of 6 feet and wearing facial coverings.

All students who are fully vaccinated against COVID-19 prior to the start of the fall semester and provide proof of vaccination will be rewarded with \$50 in Flex Funds that can be used at any dining location on campus. More details about this program will be communicated at a later date.

SRU encourages everyone in our community to get vaccinated as soon as possible. If we achieve a substantial vaccination rate, the University's return to normal in the fall will be much easier to achieve, which will allow our community to continue to thrive.

We appreciate the effort everyone is making to get vaccinated and to keep our University community safe.
