Do Freshman have to live on campus?

First year students are required to live on campus during their first year unless they are within a reasonable commuting distance and provide a notarized letter to the Office of Housing & Residence Life that they will be living at their permanent home address with their parent(s).

Can I live on campus for only one semester?

No. The Housing Agreement is for the entire academic year (meaning Fall AND Spring Semesters). If you will not be a registered student on-campus for the entire year, DO NOT SIGN AND ENTER INTO THIS AGREEMENT.

Can my parents complete the housing process for me?

We strongly advise against parents completing any of the phases of the housing process for you. This is the same process you will need to do for the next few years and so it is best that you learn to do it for yourself. We cannot give out your information (your e-mail address and password) which makes the process complicated when you are not the one doing it. We feel it is important that as you start out on this new chapter of your life begin to take initiatives for yourself. Sure, *you should talk to your parents about costs and get their input*, but really who knows what your preferences are more than you?

How/When do I sign up to live in the R.O.C.K. Apartments?

Applying for Housing is an online process in the MyHousing/MyDining portal. To reserve a space in the residence hall you must:

- Read and Sign the Housing Agreement
- Pay the \$175.00 Housing Fee (Fall Only – Reservation is credited back to you in the Spring Semester)
- Sign your Dining contract
