

Presidential Search Committee to host listening sessions April 29

SLIPPERY ROCK, Pa. – The Slippery Rock University Presidential Search Committee will solicit input from members of the University community about the selection of SRU’s next president at a pair of town hall listening sessions, April 29, in Room 321 of the Smith Student Center.

A student session is scheduled for 12:45-1:30 p.m. and a faculty forum from 1:30-2:30 p.m. Additional listening sessions with other constituency groups will be scheduled in the near future.

At each meeting, participants will have the opportunity to ask questions and provide feedback about the search, offer suggestions about the opportunities and challenges facing SRU’s next president, and discuss the skills and attributes they feel the next president should possess.

Attending the sessions will be members of the Presidential Search Committee, as well as Dana John Cohick, president, RPA Inc., the firm retained to assist in finding a successor to SRU President William Behre.
