Slippery Rock University's (SRU) Principal Certificate is designed to produce executive leaders that are capable of managing the growing complexities and demands that PK-12 Schools in Pennsylvania need today. The program addresses the development of knowledge, skills, and dispositions required to effectively lead a school by establishing an organizational vision, creating, and implementing a strategic plan, exercising shared governance, and engaging in effective decision making.
