# CERTIFICATE REQUIREMENT

To earn the School Social Work Certificate, applicants must either have a master's in social work (MSW) or plan to complete the MSW program and this certificate simultaneously.

School social workers coordinate directly with school administrations as well as students and families, providing leadership in providing, mental health intervention, crisis management, and support services.

#### ABOUT THE PROGRAM

The Slippery Rock University School Social Work Certificate meets the requirements as an approved school social worker preparation program through the Pennsylvania Department of Education.

A School Social Worker Educational Specialist certificate is issued by the PA Department of Education to an individual who:

- completes an approved school social worker certification preparation program
- holds a master's degree in social work from an accredited Council of Social Work Education (CSWE and
- is licensed through the Pennsylvania Department of State, Bureau of Occupational Affairs, as a licensed social worker (LSW) or licensed clinical social worker (LCSW)
- maintains their certification and their license to be employed under the staffing assignment as a School Social Worker in a public school
