If you decide to further your education, SRU offers a Master of Education in Technology for Online Instruction. Courses in the Teaching Online, Certificate will be transferable to the master's degree.

Slippery Rock University's graduate Teaching Online, Certificate is open to business professionals, educators, and individuals interested in learning to teach online courses.

SPED 545: Technology in Special Education

SPED 845: Instructional Technologies for Exceptional Learners (Doctoral Students Only)

Note: Courses can be taken in any order.

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

All applicants must submit the following materials along with a completed online graduate application and non-refundable application fee:

1. Official undergraduate and graduate (if applicable) transcripts
2. A minimum of a 2.75 cumulative GPA in an undergraduate major
