RN TO BSN CURRICULUM

Curriculum consists of 30 credits: 7 mandatory nursing courses (21 credits); 2 support courses (Statistics for the Social Sciences, and Medical Healthcare Ethics, 6 credits); and 1 nursing elective (3 credits). All students must meet the general studies and 120 credit minimum requirement for graduation.
