Presidents Commission on Disability Issues Commendation Letters Purpose and Procedures

Purpose: The purpose of the commendation letter is to provide recognition to a person within the SRU campus community who seeks to create a campus community that is free of barriers and discrimination and to empower people with disabilities to be full participants in all facets of university life. PCDI hopes to support and showcase people within our campus community who are going above and beyond the norm. Anyone on campus can be nominated for this commendation letter, including faculty or staff.

Procedures: Anyone within the campus community can submit a nomination on behalf of a faculty or staff member. The nomination letter can be one page in length to showcase the person's support to those with disabilities in their daily work. The President's Commission on Disability Issues will review the nomination and provide the person with a commendation letter to recognize their diligence and efforts. Nominations can be submitted anytime throughout the semester. There is no deadline. The goal of the commission is to highlight many people on campus semesterly.
