Utilizing Focus2 For Major/ Career Exploration

FOCUS2 is tool designed to assess your background to help identify majors and occupations that may be of interest. These assessments can also help you tie in skills and values into your career path. Overall, FOCUS2 can assist with your major/ career exploration, provide information on occupations related to your interests, or confirm your decisions.

Setup an Account

- Click **Register** to create an account

 - Complete the information, using your SRU email

Work Interest Assessment-identify activities you enjoy doing to determine your top three work interests and related occupations

Values Assessment-Understand how your beliefs and ideas about work match your values with majors and occupations

Skills Assessment- Defining your skills will allow you to connect your strengths to different career paths

- For best results, only choose skills that you would want to use in a future career

Personality Assessment-Compare your personality type with compatible occupations

Leisure Assessment-Identify what you do during your free time to see different occupations that may connect

Occupation Overview



Educational administrators design and implement methods to manage and measure how well an educational program is meeting its objectives. They select, develop and evaluate both the teachers and administrative staff members.

The position of educational administrator is not usually an entry level job. Many administrators begin their careers as teachers or instructors with a bachelor's degree and prepare for an administrative job by completing a master's or doctoral degree in educational administration.
