What is a Living Learning Community (LLC) and is it required?

Living-Learning Communities are optional and offer the opportunity for over 900 residence hall students to live with other students who share similar academic, career, or personal interests. If you apply for an LLC you will be assigned to whatever Building and floors house that particular LLC. Please refer to the Housing Brochure for more information about the individual Living-Learning Communities.

I am not in a Living-Learning Community (LLC) but my friend is, can I live with them?

Unfortunately, no. You cannot live with a friend who is in an LLC if you have not applied and been accepted into that same LLC. Based on your major, you must be eligible for the same academic LLC. You can either apply for an LLC or cancel your LLC application through the MyHousing portal to match your roommate's LLC status.
